RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

Panetta, Sr., President, for the REZONING, FROM CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT IN PART AND RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) IN PART TO IL-LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT of the West 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4, less the East 1.25 acres thereof of Section 19, Township 42 South, Range 43 East, less the Northerly 75.0 feet thereof for road right-of-way, subject to easements and rights-of-way of record.
