

RESOLUTION NO. R-74-773

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 74-131 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 29 August 1974.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 29th day of August, 1974, that petition No. 74-131, the petition of MAURICE F. VALIBUS for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT of the East 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 11, Township 46 South, Range 42 East. Said property located on the north side of the L.W.D.D. Lateral Canal No. 31 approximately 600 feet west of Military Trail (S.R. 809), was approved as advertised.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Warren, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner [redacted], and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


