AND MAUSOLEUMS on the North 126 acres of the East 1/4 of Section 14,
Township 42 South, Range 41 East. Said property located approximately
.5 mile north of Lake Park West Road Extension and approximately one
(1) mile west of State Road No. 7 in an AG-Agricultural District, was
approved as advertised, subject to the following special conditions:

- Developer shall dedicate to Palm Beach County and construct, Memorial Park Road as a two (2) lane paved facility from Lakd Park Road to the development's north entrance;
