## RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

Gilbert, Jr., Agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A COMMERCIAL, NEW AND USED, MOBILE HOME AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLE SALES AND RENTAL AND REPAIR FACILITIES AND LOT on Lots 52 through 59, inclusive, less the East 3 feet thereof for road right-of-way and Lots 60 through 62 inclusive, and Lots 239 through 241 inclusive, Kenwood, in Section 24, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 3, page 44, as depicted on that survey prepared by Hutcheon Engineers, Inc., Drawing No. 73-1-574, dated April, 1973, and on file at the Office of the Director of Planning, Zoning 'and Building. Said property located on the west side of Military Trail (S.R. 809) approximately .2 mile south of 10th Avenue North in a CG-General Commercial District, was approved as advertised, subject to the following special conditions:
