PITTS for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT IN PART AND CN-NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT IN PART TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT of all that part of the West 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 36, Township 43 South, Range 41 East lying North of the North right-of-way line of State Road No. 80, less the North 100 Said property located on the north side of State Road feet thereof. No. 80 (Southern Boulevard) approximately .6 mile west of State Road No. 7, was approved as amended ton include a Special Exception to allow an office/warehouse facility, subject to the following special condition:

1. Petitioner shall reserve a two hundred (200) foot right-of-way for Southern Boulevard (S.R. 80).
