## RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

OF WEST PALM BEACH, INC., by Jay MacLarty, President, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW AN INTERIM PACKAGE SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT on Lot 2, less the South 55 feet and all of Lots 22, 23 and 24, Okeechobee Garden Estates, in Section 24, Township 43 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 23, page Said property located at the northeast corner of the intersection of Okeechobee Boulevard (S.R. 704) and Spafford Avenue approximately 1/4 mile east of Military Trail (S.R. 809) in a CG-General Commercial District, was approved as advertised, subject to the following special conditions:

> Developer shall pave Spafford Avenue to a two (2) lane paved facility, from Okeechobee Boulevard to the project's north entrance;
