

RESOLUTION NO. R-75-31

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 74-194 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 19 December 1974.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 19 day of December, 1974, that petition No. 74-194, the petition of MURRAY LOGAN by Jan A. Wolfe and Associates, Inc., Agent, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT, of the North 1/2 of Tract 48, Block 5, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3, in Section 34, Township 43 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 46. Said property located approximately .3 mile north of Southern Boulevard (S.R. 80), and approximately .6 mile east of Florida's Turnpike, was approved as advertised.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Lytal, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Weaver, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

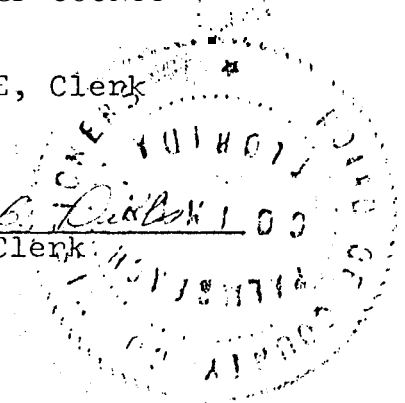
