Wagonseller, Agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW AN INTERIM SEWACE TREATMENT PLANT on Lots 1 through 25, and 50 through 74, inclusive, Block 7, West Boynton Plat No. 2C, in Section 19, Township 45 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 15, page 14. Said property located on the east side of Holt Street, on the south side of Oberon Avenue, and on the north side of Pandora Avenue in an RS- Residential Single Family District, was approved as advertised, subject to the following special conditions:

- Developer shall provide opaque screening around the subject property.
- Developer shall connect to the regional system when it is available.
