Giamatti, No. 75-33, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, of the Westerly 600 feet of the Easterly 1397 feet (as measured from the West 53 foot right-of-way line of Military Trail) of the following: the South 440 feet of the North 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 25, Township 42 South, Range 42 East, less the South 53 feet. Said property located on the north side of Blue Heron Boulevard approximately 800 feet west of Military Trail (S.R. 809), was approved as amended to include a Special Exception for an Office/Warehouse Complex, subject to the following special conditions:

- 1. Developer shall submit a traffic impact analysis.
- 2. Developer shall be responsible for all intersections and roadway improvements, including signalization necessitated by the proposed development's traffic.
- 3. **Prior** to the issuance of any building permits, the developer shall convey to Palm Beach County the additional right-of-way required to provide sixty (60) feet of rightof-way from the centerline of Blue Heron Boulevard.
