

RESOLUTION NO. R-75-292

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 75-35 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 24 April 1975.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 24th day of April, 1975, that petition No. 75-35, the petition of GOLD COAST ENTERPRISES, INC. by Gerard V. Schultz, Vice President, for the REZONING, FROM IL-LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, of the north 275 feet of the West 160 feet of the North 1/2 of Tract 9, Block 19 in Section 19, Township 46 South, Range 42 East, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 1, as recorded in Plat Book 2, pages 26, 27 and 28. Said property located on the south side of Delray West Road (S.R. 806) approximately .4 mile east of State Road No. 7, was denied as advertised.
