

RESOLUTION NO. R-75-402

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 75-47 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 29 May 1975.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 29 day of May, 1975, that petition No. 75-47, the petition of PADDOCKVILLE, INC., by Jack D. Ambrosine, President, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RE-RESIDENTIAL ESTATE DISTRICT of Tracts 19,20,21,22, Block 26, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3, in Section 24, Township 44 South, Range 41 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 47; Subject, however, to any and all rights-of-way, easements, reservations, and restrictions of record. Said property located approximately 1/4 mile west of U.S. 441 (S.R.7), being bound on the west by the L.W. D.D. Canal No. S-6, on the north by the L.W.D.D. Lateral Canal No. 11-W, and on the south by 37th Place South, was approved as advertised.

Commissioner Johnson, moved for approval of the petition. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lytal, and upon being
