

RESOLUTION NO. R-75-531

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, **as** the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 75-78 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 31 July 1975.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 31st day of July, 1975, that petition No. 75-78, the petition of EARL L. MARKLAND AND CLIFFORD R. SELLERS for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT of Lots 1 and 2, Breezy Acres, in Section 14, Township 46 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 20, page 79. Said property located at the southeast corner of the intersection of Atlantic Avenue (Delray West Road; S.R. 806) and Markland Lane, approximately .2 mile west of Military Trail (S.R. 809), was approved as amended to rezone to CS-Specialized Commercial District.
