RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, by E.W. "Bud" Weaver, Chairman for the REZONING, FROM RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT TO RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY), of Tracts 41, 42, 43 and the South 1/2 of Tract 44, less the North 100 feet thereof, and Tracts 47 and 48, less the East 800 feet thereof, and that certain 20 foot platted road right-of-way lying adjacent to the Westerly boundary of said tracts, all in Model Land Company Subdivision of Section 35, Township 43 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 5, page Said property located approximately 3/4 mile west of the intersection of Belvedere Road and Haverhill Road on the south side of Belvedere Road, was approved as amended to include a Special Exception for Single Family Development on minimum six thousand (6000) square foot lots, subject to the following special conditions:

- 1. There shall be no street connections between Lake

 Belvedere Estates Subdivision and the subject development.
- 2. Palm Beach County Engineering Department shall notify the Wynnewood Acres Home Owners Association of any proposed improvements to the Southerly extension of Drexel Road.
