

RESOLUTION NO. R-75-946

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 75-158 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 18 December 1975.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 18th day of December, 1975, that petition No. 75-158, the petition of WILLIAM L. AND EDITH A. ARRINGTON for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/11. of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 27, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, less the West 40 feet conveyed to Palm Beach County. Said property located on the east side of Jog Road approximately .4 mile south of Lake Worth Road (S.R. 802), was approved as advertised.
