Smith, Attorney, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT AND THE FURTHER SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A MOBILE HOME RENTAL PARK on property being the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4, and the West 1/2 of the West 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4, and the West 148.00 feet of the East 1/2 of the West 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 6, Township 44 South, Range 37 East, Palm Beach County, Florida; less the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest Said property located at the northwest corner of State Road 715 and State Road 80, was approved as advertised, subject to the following special conditions:

- 1. Developer shall construct a left turn lane, north approach at State Road 715 and the Development's entrance.
