RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM REACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 22nd day of April, 1976, that petition No. 76-8, the petition of GLUCKSTERN-TAYLOR ENTERPRISES by William R. Boose, III, Attorney, to amend and/or delete the following special conditions placed on Zoning Petition approval for Gluckstern-Taylor Enterprises on March 16, 1972 (72-60 and 72-61):

Condition #4 States: Dedication of the required ultimate right-of-way for Okeechobee Road and the construction of the parallel access road within the ultimate right-of-way shall be required of the developer.

Request: Amend Condition #4 to read: Dedication of the required ultimate right-of-way for Okeechobee Road.

Condition #8 States: Access for commercial areas shall be limited to one (1) on Pike Road.

Request: Delete Condition #8.

Condition #9 States: Access to Okeechobee Road shall be limited to one (1) as engineered by the Palm Beach County Engineering Department.

Request: Delete Condition #9, was approved as advertised. Commissioner Culpepper , moved for approval of the petition. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Weaver , and upon being put to a vote, the voté was as follows:
