RESOLUTION CCNYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 76-168 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 2 December, 1976.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 2d day of December, that petition No. 76-168 the petition of STEVEN R. AND VIVIAN C. IRWIN for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RE-RESIDENTIAL ESTATE DISTRICT of the North 207.77 feet of the South 986.19 feet of the West 534.64 feet of the East 1408.64 feet of the Northwest 1/4, Section 22, Township 41 South, Range 41 East; Subject to an easement for road purposes, located approximately 1.6 miles north of Bee Line Highway (S.R. 710) and approximately 6 miles west of Florida's Turnpike, was denied as advertised.
