RESOLUTION **DENYING** ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Eoard of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 76-146 **was** presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at **its** public hearing conducted on 24 February 1977

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 24th day of **February**, that petition **No. 76-146** the petition of JOHN J. CLECKNER for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RE-KESIDENTIAL ESTATE DISTRICT of the **west** 1016.87 feet **of** the East 1408.64 feet of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 22, Township 41 South, Range 41 East, less the South 1804.69 feet thereof; containing 20.003 acres, more **or** less. Said property located approximately 3 miles south of Indiantown Road and approximately 3.6 miles west of S.R. 7 (U.S. 441), was denied as advertised.
