NOW, THEREFORE, RE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMIS-SIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session 24th day of February, 1977 , that petition No, 77-23 the petition of CHEMSPRAY, INC. by Juan Montalvo, Executive Vice President, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW THE COMMERCIAL SALE AND PROCESSING OF HERBICIDE PRODUCTS UTILIZED BY AGRICULTURAL ENTERPRISES TOGETHER WITH ACCESSORY "DUSTER" AIRCRAFT ENCLOSED STORAGE STRUCTURES on a parcel of land more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the Southwest corner of Section 27, Township 42 South, Range 38 East; thence North 89° 52' 16" East 2,684.96 feet along the South line of said Section 27; thence North 0° 12' 37" West 496.70 feet; thence South 89° 07' 25" West 88.81 feet to the true Point of Beginning; thence continuing South 89° 071 25" West 298.24 feet; thence North 50° 10' 53" West 1291.98 feet; thence South 89° 17' 59" East 1,294.29 feet; thence South 0° 15' 32" West 806.96 feet to the Point of Beginning; containing 14.873 acres, more or less,
