Dick, Vice President, for the REZONING, FROM CN-NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT of a parcel of land in the Northeast 1/4 of Section 9, Township 45 South, Range 43 East, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of San Castle Boulevard and Kypoluxo Road as recorded on the Plat of San Castle, 4th Addition, Plat Book 26, Page 34, and proceed Cast along the centerline of Hypoluxo road a distance of 230 feet; thence South 4.0 feet to the Point of Beginning; continue South 220 feet parallel to the Easterly right-of-way line of said San Castle Boulevard; thence West parallel to Hypoluxo Road a distance of 230 feet to the centerline of San Castle Boulevard: thence run Northerly along the centerline 220 feet to a point which is 40 feet
