RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 24th, day of March, 1977, that petition No. 77-30 the petition of GULFSTREAM-EENTBROOK, INC. by Arnold Ramos, Vice President, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) of the East 130 feet of the North 330 feet of Tract 76, Block 32, Palm Beach Farms Company, Plat No. 3, in Section 33, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 48. Said property located approximately .3 mile north of Lantana Road and approximately .3 mile east of Florida's Turnpike, was approved as advertised.
