

RESOLUTION NO. R-77-810

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 77-86 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 28 July 1977

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 28th day of July, 1977, that petition No. 77-86 the petition of HONEY ACRE FARMS, INC., by W. A. Futch, President, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT, of the South 385 feet of the North 425 feet of the East 113.15 feet of the West 531.35 feet of the West 3/4 of the North 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 35, Township 41 South, Range 42 East; containing 1.0 acre, more or less. Said property located on the south side of Hood Road, approximately 1/2 mile east of Florida's Turnpike, was approved as advertised.
