NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 25th day of August, 1977, that petition No. 77-111 the petition of ERNEST AND DOROTHY MERRITT TO MODIFY THE FOLLOWING CONDITION PLACED ON AMERICAN MINING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT CORP. CONDITIONAL USE FOR A SHELL ROCK MINING OPERATION:

- (2) Performance bond in the amount of \$1500.00 per acre on a form prescribed by the County Commission, was approved for a one (1) year extension to comply, with the reclamation requirement.

Commissioner Evatt, moved for approval of the petition. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Medlen, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

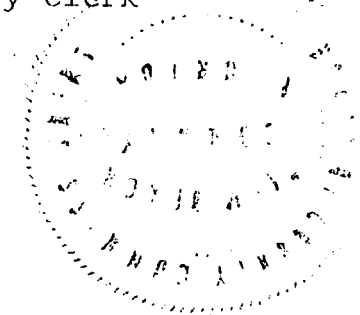
