

RESOLUTION NO. R-77-954

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 77-113 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on August 25, 1977,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 25th day of August, 1977, that petition No. 77-113 the petition of GRIFFIN BROTHERS CO., a partnership, by Richard A. Griffin, General Partner, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW THE EXCAVATION AND REMOVAL OF ROCK on Section 22, Township 47 South, Range 37 East; containing 639.7 acres, more or less. Said property located on the north side of County Line Road, approximately 5.5 miles west of the intersection of S.R. 25 (U.S. 27) and the S.F.W.M.D. L-5 Canal in an AG-Agricultural District, was approved as advertised subject to the following special conditions.

1. Developer shall not conduct any excavation within seven hundred thirty (730) feet of the South Florida Water Management District right-of-way line, as shown on the site plan.

Commissioner Bailey, moved for approval of the petition.

put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


