

RESOLUTION NO. R-77-1189

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 77-131 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 29 September 1977.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 25th day of October, 1977, that petition No.77-131 the petition of YURIC ASSOCIATES, by Conrad W. Schaeffer, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY' DISTRICT of Tracts 20 and 21, Block 79, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3, in Section 20, Township 47 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, pages 45 through 54 together with the North 15.00 feet of that certain 30 foot platted road Right-of-way, lying Southerly of adjacent, and contiguous to said Tracts 20 and 21 as shown on said Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3. Said property located on the north side of 212th Place South, approximately .5 mile west of Florida's Turnpike, was approved as advertised, Commissioner Medlen, moved for approval of the petition.
