

RESOLUTION NO. R-77- 1239

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 77-138 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 27 October 1977.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 8th day of November, 1977, that petition No. 77-138 the petition of DAIRELL J. SNAPP, BENNETT S. COHN, AND ROBERT NEEDLE for the REZONING, FROM CN-NEIGH-BORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, IN PART, AND RM-RESIDEN-TIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY), IN PART, TO CS-SPECIALIZED COMMERCIAL DISTRICT of Tract 2, Block 1, less the Southerly 27 feet for road, Lakewood Gardens Plat No. 1, in Section 19, Township 44 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 18, page 38; containing 0.81 acres, more or less. Said property located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Gulf Stream Road and Lake Worth Road (S.R. 8021, approximately 3/4 mile west of Congress Avenue (S.R. 8071, was approved as advertised.
