RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. ~~73-2~~ have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 77-168 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 17 November 1977.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 17 day of November, 1977, that petition No. 77-168 the petition of ANTONIO O. VIZOSO ET AL, by Robert McK. Foster, Esquire, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO IL-LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT of The Easterly 238.75 feet of Tract 6, Block 6, according to the Plat of Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3, in Section 32, Township 43 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 46, less the Northerly 22 feet thereof, containing in all 3.5 acres, more or less. Said property located on the south side of Belvedere Road approximately 800 feet east of Benoist Farms Road, was approved as advertised.
