RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 77-187 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 26 January 1978

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 26th day of January, 1978, that petition No. 77-187 the petition of BOYNTON BEACH DEVELOPMENT, INC., by Joesph DeMarco, President, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW MIGRANT AND TRANSIENT FARM LABOR QUARTERS AND CAMP, AND ON-SITE WATER AND SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANTS on all that part of the South 310 feet of the East 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 25, Township 46 South, Range 41 East, lying West of the West right-of-way line of State Road 199, (No. 7), as recorded in Road Plat Book 1, Page 37. Said property located on the west side of S.R. 7 (U.S. 441), approximately .2 mile south of 160th Street South in an AG-Agricultural District, was denied as advertised.

Commissioner Medlen, moved for denial of the petition.

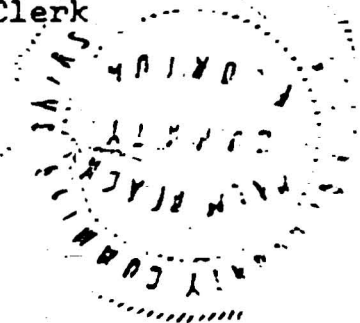
