

RESOLUTION NO. R-78- 276

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No, 78-21 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 23 February 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 23^d day of February, 1978, that petition No. 78-21 the petition of WEST PALM BEACH LODGE NO. TWO, FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE, INC. , by William C. Hess, President, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A PISTOL AND SMALL BORE RIFLE TARGET SHOOTING RANGE AS AN ACCESSORY TO AN EXISTING CLUBHOUSE AND MEETING HALL on the West 1/2 of Tract 36, in Block 7, Palm Beach Farms Co. Plat No.3, in Section 32, Township 43 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 45 to 54 inclusive, less the South 217.8 feet of the West 200 feet thereof, Said property located on the north side of Hooper Road, approximately 400 feet west of Benoist Farms Road in an AG-Agricultural District, was approved as advertised subject to the following special conditions:

1. Petitioner shall provide a six (6) foot chain link fence around the subject pistol range.
2. The subject facility shall be brought up to the standards of the National Rifle Association.
3. Petitioner shall provide signage identifying the target shooting range and its related danger.
