

RESOLUTION NO. R-78- 288

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS , the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-42 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 23 February 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 23^d day of February, 1978 , that petition No. 78-42 the petition of BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS , PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLOKIDA, by Peggy Evatt, Chairman, for the REZONING, FROM RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT TO AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4, South of Germantown Road; the Northwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4; the Southwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 25, Township 46 South, Range 42 East, Excepting a strip of land 40 feet in width lying on each side of centerline of any County Road and rights-of-way of the Lalce Worth Drainage District as laid-out on October 15, 1945, as in Deed Book 732, Page 377. Said property located on the south side of Germantown Road, approximately .8 mile east of Military Trail (S.R. 809), was approved as advertised.

Commissioner Medlen , moved for approval of the petition.
