Said property located on the south Lateral Canal No.39, approximately 1 3/4 miles west side of L.W.D.D. of Military 'Trail (S.R.809), was approved as advertised subject to the following special conditions:

- 1. Developer shall dedicate a sixty (60) foot right-of-way for Boniello Road.
- 2. Within ninety (90) days of the Special Exception approval, the Developer shall place five hundred dollars (\$500.00) in escrow with Palm Beach County for his pro rata share of construction of improvements to the left turn lane, south approach, at Clint Moore Road and Military Trail.
