RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No, 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-63 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 27 April 1978.

NOW , THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 27th day of April, 1978 , that petition No. 78-63 the petition of LARRY S. AND JEANETTE SLAYMAKER for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RE-RESIDENTIAL ESTATE DISTRICT of the North 657.54 ft. of the South 1972.62 feet of the East 1/4 of the East 1/2 of Section 4, Township 41 South, Range 41 East; less the North 334.06 feet thereof and subject to a road easement for ingress and egress over the East 40.0 feet and over the North 15.0 feet thereof.
