NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMIS-SIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session April, 1978 the 27th day of \_ , that petition 78-64 the petition of THE CHURCH OF JESUS CHRIST, by MICHAEL RADD, Pastor, for the REZONING FROM CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) AND THE FURTHER SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A CHURCH AND ACCESSORY BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES on a parcel of land in the North 1/2 of Section 24, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, better known as Model Land Company Subdivision, in said Section 24, as recorded in Plat Book 5, page 76, being the East 100.0 feet of Tract 19, less the subdivision of Kenwood, in said Section 24, as recorded in Plat Book 3, pages 44 & 45, and less the North 20.0 feet, and less the East 30.0 feet for Attleboro Avenue according to the Plat thereof.
