RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 27th day of April, 1978, that petition No. 78-81 the petition of BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, BY Peggy Evatt, Chairman, for the REZONING, FROM PO-PUBLIC OWNERSHIP DISTRICT TO RE-RESIDENTIAL ESTATE DISTRICT of a parcel of land in Section 5, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, more particularly described as follows: the East 330 feet of the West 430 feet of Tract 24, Block 12, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3, as recorded in Plat Book 2, pages 46-54, Said property located on the south side of Pioneer Road (2nd Place South), approximately 100 feet east of Benoist Road (80th Avenue South), was approved as advertised.
