RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners , as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-110 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 25 May 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 25th day of May, 1978 , that petition No. 78-110 the petition of MAHLON WEIR, by Daniel J. O'Brien, Agent for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO IL-LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT of the South 361.50 feet of the West 162.80 feet of Tract 117, Block 18, Palm Beach Farms Co. Plat No. 1, in Section 18, Township 46 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 27, less the right-of-way for West Atlantic Avenue (S.R. 806). Said property located on the north side of Delray West Road (S.R. 806), approximately .2 mile east of S.R. 7 (U.S. 441), was approved as advertised,
