Goss, Agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW THE PARKING OF ONE (1) MOBILE HOME AS A TEMPORARY RESIDENCE on a parcel of land in the Southwest 1/4 of Section 36, Township 43 South, Range 41 East, being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Southwest 1/4 of said Section 36; thence North 87°56'22" West, along the South line of the Southwest 1/4 of said Section 36, a distance of 301.76 feet; thence North 04°10'13" East, a distance of 904.83 feet to an intersection with a line 330 feet South of and parallel to the South right-of-way line of the West Palm Beach Canal; thence South 87°30'28" East, along said parallel line, a distance of 277.32 feet to an intersection with the East line of the Southwest 1/4 of said Section 36; thence South 02°39'00" West, along said East line a distance of 902.32 feet to the

Point of Beginning; subject to a right-of-way easement for ingress and egress over the North 30.0 feet thereof.
