No. Ewseychik, Jr., Agent, for the REZONING, FROM CN-NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT AND THE FURTHER SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A PLANNED OFFICE/WAREHOUSE COMBINATION on the South 1/2 of Tract 12, less the East 265.0 feet and the South 40.0 feet thereof, Model Land Company's Subdivision of the North 1/2 of Section 24, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 5, page 76. property located on the north side of 10th Avenue North, approximately 250 feet west of Military Trail (S.R. 809), was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Within ninety (90) days of the Special Exception approval, petitioner shall dedicate to Palm Beach County a total of fifty-four (54) feet from the centerline for the ultimate right-of-way for Tenth Avenue North.
