

RESOLUTION NO. R-78- 876

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-97 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 29 June 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 29th day of June, 1978, that petition No. 78-97 the petition of PAHOKEE BUILDERS, LTD. by W.H. Acree, Jr., General Partner for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) of the South 427.30 feet of the North 552.30 feet of Tract 8 and the South 427.30 feet of the North 552.30 feet of the West 222.00 feet of Tract 7 as measured from the North line of Section 20, Township 42 South, Range 37 East, as recorded in Plat Book 7, page 2. Said property located on the south side of State Road 717 (Muck City Road), approximately 200 feet east of State Road 15-A, was approved as advertised.
