Roy, Agent, €or the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT AND THE FURTHER SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT on all of Tracts 89, 90 and 91, Block 79, Palm Beach Farms Company, Plat No. 3, in Section 20, Township 47 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 53, less the South 240 feet thereof; together with all that portion of Tract 88, of said Block 79, lying west of the West right-of-way line of the Florida State Turnpike, less the East 60 feet and the South 240 feet Said property located on the west side of Boca Rio Road, approxthereof. imately .2 mile north of Pondwood Road (220th Street South), was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Developer shall construct a left turn lane, east approach, on Boca Lago Boulevard at the development's entrance at time of construction.
- 2. Developer shall contribute a fair share toward reducing the traffic impact of the project in the amount of sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000.00) provided, however, that if the County adopts a "Fair Share Contribution" Ordinance the provisions of the Ordinance shall supersede this condition.
- 3. Developer shall donate 0.2 of 1% of the final unit sales price to the Palm Beach County School Board for capital outlay purposes.
