

RESOLUTION NO. R-78-881

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and .

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-79 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 29 June 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 29th day of June, 1978, that petition No. 78-79 the petition of JAMES L. AND CATHERINE E. EVANS for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW EXCAVATION AND REMOVAL OF MUCK, SAND, SOIL OR OTHER EXTRACTIVE MATERIALS on the North 327 feet of the South 3920 feet of the West 1/2 of the East 1/2 of the West 1/2 of Section 1, Township 45 South, Range 41 East, also known as Tract 38W. Said property located on the west side of Park Lane East (106th Trail South), approximately .7 mile north of Heritage Road (71st Street South) in an AG-Agricultural District, was denied as advertised.
