

4. Within thirty (30) days of the Special Exception approval, petitioner shall remove all trash from the subject site.
5. All scrap tires shall be stored within a water-tight building.
6. No junk vehicles, trash, **other** debris, or other such activity shall be permitted on the site.
7. Landscaping as submitted on the Site Plan, Exhibit No. 10, on 'file in the office of the Director, Department of Planning, Zoning & Building, shall **be** completed prior to the issuance of an Occupational License,

Commissioner **Lytal** moved **for** approval **of** the petition.

The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Medlen**, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was **as** follows:
