THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMIS-SIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session 24th day of August , 1978 the , that petition 78-175 the petition of JAMES NEMEC, TRUSTEE, by Kieran Kilday, Agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A USED AUTOMOBILE SALES LOT AND AUTOMOBILE SOUND EQUIPMENT INSTALLATION FACILITY on Lots 25 to 30 inclusive, Block 5, Amended Plat of Block 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and the Northern part of Block 'A', Westgate Estates in Section 30, Township 43 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 9, page 20. Said property located on the south side of Okeechobee Boulevard (S.R. 704), approximately .1 mile west of Congress Avenue (S.R. 802) in a CG-General Commercial District, was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Petitioner shall pave Shawnee Avenue from Loxahatchee Drive to the westerly property line.
- 2. Petitioner shall remove the excess paving along Okeechobee Boulevard and shall replace same with grass.
- 3. No display vehicles shall be permitted in areas designated as green areas.

- 4. No display vehicles shall be parked within the customer parking area as said area is designated on the Site Plan, Exhibit No. 10, on file in the office of the Director, Department of Planning, Zoning E Building,
- 5. The total number of display vehicles shall be limited to a maximum of seventeen (17) vehicles.
- 6. No Occupational License shall be granted until the landscaping as shown on the Site Plan, Exhibit No. 10, on file in the office of the Director, Department of Planning, Zoning & Building, is completed.
- 7. All landscaping shall he in conformance with the Palm Beach County Landscape Code.
