

RESOLUTION NO. R-78-1246

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-188 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 25 September 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 25th day of September, 1978, that petition No. 78-188 the petition of LEONORA ORLANDO for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A DAY CARE CENTER on the East 1/2 of Lots 53 and 54, and the East 1/2 of the North 1/2 of Lot 55, HI-PINES HOMESITES PLAT NO. 2, in Section 20, Township 44 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 23, page 38. Said property located on the south side of Tenth Avenue North, approximately 650 feet east of Congress Avenue (S.R. 807) in an RH-Residential Multiple Family (High Density) District, was denied as advertised.
