WALKER for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW THE PARKING OF ONE (1) MOBILE HOME AS A TEMPORARY RESIDENCE on a parcel of land in Tract 8, Block G, being more particularly described as follows: The West 403.33 feet of Tract 8, Block G, Loxahatchee Groves, in Section 22, Township 43 South, Range 41 East, as recorded in Plat Book 12, page 29. Said property located on'the northeast corner of the intersection of Folsom Road and 25th Street North, approximately .4 mile north of Okeechobee Road (S.R. 704) in an AG-Agricultural District, was approved as advertised subject to the following condition:

1. The term of the Special Exception allowing the parking of the mobile home as a temporary residence shall be limited to a maximum of five (5) years because of the changing character of the area.
