RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

Weyant, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RH-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (HIGH DENSITY), of the East 235.00 feet of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 6, Township 44 South, Range 37 East; subject to right-of-way for S.R. 80 and South Florida Conservancy District Canal rights-of-way. Said property located on the north side of S.R. 80, approximately 425 feet east of S.R. 715, was approved as advertised.


