

RESOLUTION NO. R- 79-86

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-272 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 28 December 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 23th day of January, 1979, that petition No. 78-272 the petition of ARTHUR R. and LORRAINE G. LYMAN for the REZONING, FROM CN-NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT of Lot 1 of McS' Acres in Section 24, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 21, page 81. Said property located on the northwest corner of the intersection of Lake Worth Road (S.R. 802) and Wisconsin Street, was approved as advertised,
