Miller, No. Agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW THE ADDITION OF A CAR WASH TO AN EXISTING AUTO SERVICE STATION on Lots 22 through 30, inclusive, Block 1, The Amended Plat of West Gate Estates, in Section 30, Township 43 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 9, page 20, subject to easements and rights-of-way of record. Said property located on the southwest corner of the intersection of Okeechobee Boulevard (S.R. 704) and Wabasso Drive in a CG-General Commercial District, was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Petitioner shall pave Shawnee Avenue from Wabasso Drive to the westerly property limits of the subject property.
