RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No, 79-32 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 25 January 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 25th day of January, 1979, that petition No. 79-32 the petition of FRANK W. and MARY ODOM and ROBERT G. and ANNA MAE SALMON, by LeWanda Fix, Agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT on Tract 30, Block 13, Palm Beach Farms Co., Plat No. 3, in Section 4, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, pages 45-54 inclusive. Said property located on the east side of Cleary Road, approximately .2 mile south of Pioneer Road in an RE-Residential Estate District, was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

- 1. This development shall be limited to a maximum of four (4) lots, and each lot shall be limited to one (1) single family detached home.
- 2. The petitioner shall enter into a formal contract with the School Board of Palm Beach County to contribute .4 of 1% of the selling price of each residential dwelling unit in this planned unit development on a one time initial sales basis. However, if an ordinance dealing with this subject matter is adopted, this condition will be superceded by that ordinance; except that regardless of the form or status of any ordinance, this development shall be required to provide as a minimum the above .4 of 1% of the initial sales price toward alleviating some of the development's school impact.
