

RESOLUTION NO. R-79- 360

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, **is** authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance **No.** 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-276 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 22 February 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 22d day of **February, 1979**, that petition **No.** 78-276 the petition of ISIDOR MOSKOWITZ for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT on Lot 7, **less** the West 1/4 thereof, Block 4, Model Land Company Subdivision of Section 12, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, Palm Beach Plantations, as recorded in Plat Book 10, page 20. Said property located on the south side of Forest Hill Boulevard, approximately .3 mile east of Military Trail (S.R. 809) in an RM-Residential Multiple Family District (Medium Density), was denied as advertised.
