NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMIS-SIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session March, 1979 t h e day of , that petition 29th 79-25 the petition of VENTURE NEWS AND BOOK, INC., by Ray Morgan, No Agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW AN ADULT ENTERTAINMENT ESTABLISHMENT on the East 67 feet of the West 87 feet of the North 360 feet of the East 1/2 of the North 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 26, Township 43 South, Range 42 East, less the North 50 feet and the South 60 feet thereof. Said property located on the south side of Okeechobee Boulevard, approximately .2 mile west of Haverhill Road in a CG-General Commercial District, was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Petitioner shall construct a six (6) foot high masonry wall along the south property line.
- 2. The building shall not be painted in bright or garish colors so as to unduly attract attention, nor shall pictures or silhouettes be painted on the building. The use of earthtone colors is suggested.
- 3. Petitioner shall comply with the Site Plan, Exhibit No. 11, on file in the Office of the Director of the Department of Planning, Zoning and Building. Said site plan shall be subject to the approval of the Site Plan Review Committee.
